MEETING SCHEDULE

Wind Meadows Corporation Monthly Board Meeting: Tuesday, September 15, 2020 at 7pm, will be held via tele/video conference call. Information on how to join the meeting will be sent to your email prior to the meeting and should not be shared with anyone other than members of Wind Meadows Corp.

IMPORTANT MEADOW LAKE INFO –NATIVE PLANTINGS

Lake Meadow is “common area” which is maintained by Wind Meadows through Reliable Lawn Services. Owners should not remove or spray any of the existing native plants that are along the shoreline. Your lawn should not meet the waters edge, there is a buffer zone that exists of vegetation that keeps storm water runoff and pollutants from entering the water. Preserving the natural appearance of the shoreline protects against shoreline erosion and requires less formal repair and provides increased diversity and improved habitat for wildlife. Again, please do not remove or weed spray any of the native shore plants and prairie around the lake. In the future, the Association may consider openings certain areas up for visual and physical assess to the water.

ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW COMMITTEE (ARC)

All exterior changes need prior approval from the WMC Board of Directors and the ARC. This applies to ALL residents in Wind Meadows (Single Family, Manor, Patio, Garden, Village and Prairie Meadow Homes). An “ARC Request for Change” form is available on the WMC website or contact the WMC office. ARC submissions should include details of the change, including pictures. ARC meetings are held as needed and Board meetings are normally on the third Tuesday of every month. Requests are due 30 days prior to the Board meeting. After approval, it is the homeowner’s responsibility to obtain any necessary building permits, etc. required by the Village of Wind Point.

VILLAGE OF WIND POINT (VWP) BRANCH PICK-UP

The VWP branch collection schedule can be found on the home page calendar on the Village of Wind Point’s website www.windpoint.org. As of today the scheduled date is September 8, 2020. Branches will be collected up to 4 inches in diameter and 8 feet in length. Keep pile height to 4 feet and place piles by the road in small, reasonably uniform piles with the cut-end toward the road, all in the same direction. Residents in PSA I, II, III, V, VI and VIII need to inform the VWP of your branch pile by calling 262-639-3524. Do not set branch piles out sooner than seventy-two hours of collection day. Do not throw branches in the woods or wild area.
